The State of Texas. Be it remembered that a special term

and where the following proceedings were had to wit:

brick of the Court House It is ordered by the Court that  
Judge F. L. Waller and Commissioner  
W. J. Delafield be and stay their authority and  
directed to sell the brick of the Court House  
at \$42 per thousand.

In the Matter of Official bonds of September 23<sup>rd</sup> 1895  
of County & Precinct officers It is ordered by the Court that  
October 7<sup>th</sup> be set for receiving  
and approving County and Precinct officers bonds and  
for any other business that may come before the Court.

Is. the Matter of paying F. B. September 23<sup>rd</sup> 1895  
to W. S. Hull for 200 Rollers It is ordered by the Court that  
shelving placed in Clerk's office F. B. & W. S. Hull be allowed the  
sum of \$300 for two hundred  
Roller shelving placed in Sheriff or Clerk's office and that the Clerk  
of this Court issue drafts to them for said sum on the Court  
House and jail fund.

Is. to F. B. W. S. Hull In the Matter of the sum of September 23<sup>rd</sup> 1895  
pay of Court Sheriff It is ordered by the Court that F. B. W. S. Hull be allowed  
\$10.00 J. H. Delafield, J. H. Williams, E. T. Brown and  
W. J. D. Myers be allowed the sum of Three Dollars each for holding Court  
and that G. B. Dickson Sheriff be allowed two dollars for waiting on the  
Court and that drafts issued on the City County fund.
