 It is ordered by the Court that J. F. Merritt be appointed Con-  
 stable of Precinct No. 5 of Tittus County Texas.

 J. A. Wilson (ex. Contractor) } It is ordered by the Court that  
 the bond of J. A. Wilson be for  
 the erection of a new Court House on the Public Square in  
 the town of Mt Pleasant Texas presented at this term of  
 Court be and the same is hereby approved and filed with  
 the County Judge of Tittus County Texas.

In the matter of approving the } November 18<sup>th</sup> 1895  
 Bonds of E. Y. Brown and } It is ordered by the Court  
 J. F. Merritt } that the bonds of E. Y. Brown  
 as Commissioner and Justice of  
 the Peace of Precinct No. 3 and J. F. Merritt as Constable  
 of Precinct No. 5 of Tittus County Texas be and the same  
 are hereby approved.

In the matter of the account } November 18<sup>th</sup> 1895  
 of E. Y. Brown Commissioner } It is ordered by the  
 of Precinct No. 3, for \$6.<sup>00</sup> } Court that E. Y. Brown  
 Commissioner of Precinct  
 No. 3. be allowed the sum of six dollars for holding  
 Court for which scrip was issued and burned in Court House  
 said scrip to issue on the General County funds

The matters of changing the *November 18<sup>th</sup> 1895*  
 W.P. Pleasant & Stephenson *It is ordered by the court*  
 Ferry roads *that the W.P. Pleasant and*  
*Stephenson Ferry roads be changed*  
 as follows to leave the old Stephenson ferry road when  
 the Hart's Bluff intersects the same near F. T. Hollands  
 residence thence due west with Ross Street to intersect  
 the Glassville Road at C. W. Embry's residence.

*that F. L. Waller County Judge*
