December 30<sup>th</sup> 1895

It is ordered by the Court that the petition of W. F. Willson and others to change the Black Bridge and Jefferson road as follows. Beginning there W. F. Willson's West boundary line crosses said road and where L. H. Evans East boundary line crosses said road. Thence south with W. F. Willson's L. H. Evans land line a distance of about 350 Yds. or so. Thence south east about 70 yds. where said road will intersect said Black Bridge of Jefferson Road. said change being about 50 yds. near and on better ground to ground

# Mt Pleasant Incorporation for School District

In the matter the result of an Election for incorporating the Mt Pleasant Independent Incorporated, <sup>Public Free</sup> School District

The following is the result of an election held in the town of Mount Pleasant on the 30<sup>th</sup> day of December 1895 - for the purpose of determining whether or not the following miles and bounds should be established as the Mount Pleasant Independent Incorporated, <sup>Public Free</sup> School District which is as follows to wit - Beginning at Center of where the Court house stood on the 20<sup>th</sup> day of September 1895 - thence East two miles - thence North two miles - thence West four miles - thence South four miles. thence East four miles - thence North two miles to the place of beginning - For Incorporations 86 votes  
Against Incorporations 14 votes
