In the matter of deposing } January 17th 1896
of Court house bonds } It is ordered by the Court
that F.L. Waller County Judge
of Titus County, Texas, is hereby authorized and directed
to turn over the Court House Bonds last \$2500.00 to the
First National Bank of Mount Pleasant to receive the
money therefor and to turn said money into the County
Treasury, and to bring the Treasurers receipt for same.
It is further ordered by the Court that said County
Judge is authorized and directed to invest \$2500.00
of the permanent school funds of Titus County
Texas in Court House bonds remaining in his hands
It is further ordered by the Court that S. J. Webb County
Treasurer is authorized and directed to pay off G. B. &
W. S. Hulls check of \$18⁰⁰ balance due them for the erection
of Vault building on Court House square -

In the matter of the account } January 17th 1896
of G. M. Weems for \$2⁰⁰ } It is ordered by the Court
that G. M. Weems be allowed
the sum of \$2⁰⁰ for services as guard in conveying
J. J. Smith to the Family Asylum and that draft issue to him
for same on the General County fund -

In the matter of the account } January 17th 1896
of F. L. Waller County Judge } It is ordered by the Court
for \$2⁰⁰ } that F. L. Waller County Judge
be allowed the sum of
\$2⁰⁰ for superintending work on Vault building and that
draft issue to him on Court House Jail fund for same -

Account In the matter of the account of M. J. Belafield for \$20⁰⁰ January 17th 1896
 It is ordered by the Court that M. J. Belafield be allowed the sum of \$20⁰⁰ for superintending the erection of the vault building and that draft issue to him on the Court House & Jail funds for same.

Account In the matter of the account of Chas Florin for \$6⁰⁰ January 17th 1896
 It is ordered by the Court that Chas Florin be allowed \$6⁰⁰ for coffin furnished for Dela Tubb deceased and that draft issue to him on the General County fund for same.

Account In the matter of the account of F. L. Waller for \$144⁵⁰ January 17th 1896
 It is ordered by the Court that F. L. Waller County Judge be allowed the sum of \$144⁵⁰ Express charges paid by him on bonds and citations and that draft issue to him for same on the Court House & Jail funds

Account In the matter of the account of F. C. Morris for \$21²⁵ January 17th 1896
 It is ordered by the Court that F. C. Morris be allowed the sum of \$21²⁵ for 7525 lbs. of coal for Clerk's office and that draft issue to him on Court House & Jail funds for same.

Account In the matter of the account of O. C. Dodd for 50⁰⁰ January 17th 1896
 It is ordered by the Court that O. C. Dodd be allowed the sum of fifty cents for hauling on road to fill wash and that draft issue on R. B. fund for same.

In the matter of applications of J. M. Edmond to change Mt Pleasant & Pope Bridge roads January 17th 1896
 It is ordered by the Court that J. M. Edmond be allowed to change the Mt Pleasant & Pope bridge roads as follows - Beginning at some of his 6 acre tract on said road thence N. 77. 140 yds. to said road -

Account In the matter of per diem pay of Court & Sheriff January 17th 1896
 It is ordered that R. L. Waller, M. J. Belafield, J. A. Rivers & M. Myers be allowed \$3⁰⁰ each for hauling Court and R. B. Dickerson for waiting on Court and drafts issue on Gen. Co. fund for same.
