such a large building - It is ordered by the Court
that P. L. Wallen County Judge be and he is hereby
authorized and directed to notify W. S. & R. Hall to
appear before this Court and defend their plans
and specifications -

In the Matter of jury of inquest February 20th 1896
to lay out New Road This day came onto the record
the report of J. B. Black
H. S. Sumner and W. B. Thurner a jury of men to
lay out a new road a follows from New Hope Church run-
ning East by Henry Sumner and J. B. Black through J. M.
Sikes land by C. J. Blackburn by W. B. Thurner to James
McBride on Mt Pleasant and Paris Roads - It appearing
to the Court that said road is properly laid out with no
expense to the County. It is ordered by the Court that the same
be declared a public road and that lands be apporioned to com-

moners to all In the Matter of per diem pay of February 21st 1896
Judge Commissioners & Sheriff It is ordered by the Court
that F. L. Wallen County Judge
W. J. Belafield, J. A. Rivers, E. G. Brown and F. H. Myers
be allowed the sum of \$6 for holding Court to day
and that G. B. Dixon Sheriff be allowed \$4 for waiting
on Court and that draft issue on the General County Fund
