 thereto. It is now resolved
 by this Court that none of the charges in said Complaint were sustained by the evidence that the Superintendant has faithfully and impartially discharged all his duties as such Superintendant and that he was correct in condemning all material condemned by him and in condemning the foundation of said house. We further find the said J. A. Wilson & Co have failed to perform the material called for in the Contract and that he has proceeded to put in the present foundation over the protest of the Superintendant in violation of his Contract and has permitted to be and has used in the said foundation material inferior to the quality called for by said Contract and after he had been notified by the Superintendant not to use said material in said foundation and had promised not to use. We therefore decline to discharge the said Superintendant. It is further ordered by the order of this Court that said J. A. Wilson & Co is not erecting said house in accordance with the Contract and persistently

refuses to follow the directions of the Superintendent and what course of conduct if persisted in will justify this Court under the stipulations of the contract to terminate his employment. It is further ordered that the Clerk furnish the said J. A. Wilson a copy of these minutes -
