The State of Texas. Be it remembered that a regular County of Titus Court of the Honorable County Commissioners Court was begun and held within and for Titus County Texas at the Court House thereof in the town of Mt Pleasant on the 2nd Monday in August 1896 the same being the 11th day of said Month. Hon. G. L. Waller County Judge presiding Present W. J. Belfield, J. A. Burnet, C. G. Brown and J. M. Myers Commissioners, G. H. Dickson Sheriff and S. G. Williams County Clerk where and where the following proceedings were had to wit:

In the Matter of the petition of J. F. Gardaway and others to say come onto be for a new school District examined the application of J. F. Gardaway

and others for an order of Court making a new school District out of portions of Franklin and Pittsburg - It appearing to the Court that said petition is in proper form, etc. the Judge of the County Court of Franklin County Texas has approved the same - where being no objection filed and that it would be more convenient - It is therefore ordered by the Court that the following School District be made - and known as school District No. 27 with the following boundaries with Beginning on the N. E. line of Titus County at a point where Mr. Lawrence N. B. line crosses said Titus County line. Thence west with Mr. Lawrence N. B. line to a point on the Mt Vernon and Pittsburg road where said N. B. line crosses said road - thence South 20° to a point on Dr. H. Parish N. B. line containing due south across said Parish land a stake on his S. E. line - thence East with said Parish N. B. line a stake on said line the same being the N. W. corner Andrew Miller's and the N. E. corner of Adam Edgar's land. thence South with the S. E. line of said Adam Edgar to his S. E. corner the same being the N. E. corner of Major Eaton's land - thence south with said Eaton's S. E. line to his S.  of the third class leading from the Franklin County
 line near Curtis Mill running East between Blackton
 and Custer - thence between John ~~Lane~~^{Hood} and
 Curtis crossing Ripley Creek to the Franklin
 bridge - thence up the creek to Curtis farm - thence
 between Curtis and Moon land to Curtis house
 crossing a tract of land belonging to T. H. Caldwell
 thence through R. Buchanan tract of land to old
 line of John Lane tract - thence with old road to
 mouth of lane between John Lane & Harris old place
 thence through said lane with Mrs. Harper's old
 line running South - thence East between Mrs. Harper
 & Jerry Lane - thence East to James Laine's old line
 thence with the old road (or present traveled road) intersecting
 the McLean and Paris at McCallough
 creek on Dr. J. S. Black farm - the corner therein now
