a public road in the Commissioners Court
of Peters County on the undersigned from
holders and residents of the County of Peters
and State of West and duly appointed a jury
by the Commissioners Court of said County
at the May Term thereof A.D. 1897 as appears
by the records of said Court to lay out, survey
and describe a certain road designated
in the petition of J. W. Kelley and others
for a public road having first been duly
surveyed according to law and after giving
the five days notice in writing to the
land owner through whose lands said pro-
posed road may run or to his agent or attorney
as required by law did on the 22 day
of July 1897 - Proceed to view, lay out, survey
and describe the premises described in
said petition and would recommend that
said 2 Class road be established in ac-
cordance with the field notes survey and
description of same as follows - Beginning
at what is known as the Pine Bridge
on White Oak - thence North to W. W.

Lambeth Court boundary line - Thence N.W. to said Lambeth N.W. Corner then S.W. corner of R. Minus line, thence North with said Minus W.R.B. line to J.W. Walker S.W. corner - thence North to said Walkers S.W. corner - thence north across a part of the Orlando James survey to W.W. Lambeth south East corner a part of the Orlando James survey - thence north east said Lambeth E.W.B. line to his N.E. corner - thence West to his N.W. corner - thence N. on P.P. Lambeth E.W.B. line to his N.E. corners - thence East to P.C. Major's S.E. corner - thence North with his E.W.B. line to his N.E. corner. thence N.E. F.G. James S.W. corner - in the S.T.B. line of the Hopkins survey - thence N. to Mrs. A.H. Johnson's S.T.B. line & thence East to her S.E. corner thence North to said John W.W. corner - thence North to the corners of Franklin and Peters Co. corner on Edelphens - we would also report that having notified all the parties interested of our intended meeting and of the purpose thereof and no claims being presented we did proceed to lay out said road as above described all of which is respectfully submitted - asking our fee for one day's service in testimony whereof we hereunto set our hands this 2d day of July 1897
