Court House and Jail and Bridge Bonds
State of Texas On this the 14th day of February

It is ordered by the County Commissioners
Court of Titus County that the bonds of said
County to be called "Bridge Bonds" County Bonds
be issued under and by virtue of an act of the
23rd Legislature approved May 3rd, 1893, entitled
"An act to Authorize the County Commissioners
Courts of the several counties of the State
to render Court House and Jail and Bridge
bonds, or either, and to repeal all other
law authorizing the issuance of County
Court House and jail and County Bridge
bridge bonds for the purpose of purchasing
or constructing bridges for public purposes.
Said bonds shall be numbered consecutively from
1 to 10 inclusive shall be of the denomination
of \$500⁰⁰ each, aggregating Five thousand dollars
(\$5000.00) They shall be dated the 14th day of
February 1898 shall become due and payable
Forty years from date, but may be redeemed
at the pleasure of the County, at any time
after ten years from said date. They shall
bear interest at the rate of six percent
per annum, payable Annually on the 10th
day of April of each year. Principal and
interest shall be payable upon presentation.

and surrender of bond or proper coupon, in lawful money of the United States at Treasurer's office at Mt Pleasant, Texas. The said bonds shall be signed, by the County Judge, countersigned by the County Clerk and registered by the County Treasurer, and the seal of the Commissioners Court shall be impressed upon each of them. It is further ordered by the Court that, to pay interest on said bonds and create a sinking fund sufficient to discharge them at maturity, a tax of five cents on each one hundred dollar valuation of all taxable property in said Tarrant County shall be annually levied on said property, and annually assessed and collected until said bonds with interest are paid and said tax is here now levied for the payment current year, and for each succeeding year while said bonds are outstanding, and the same shall be assessed and collected for the current year and annually thereafter, and applied to the purpose named. It is also ordered that B. H. Rogers County Judge be authorized to take charge of said bonds pending their investigation by the Attorney General and upon their approval shall have authority to negotiate their sale and receive for the County the proceeds thereof.
