The State of Texas Be it remembered that
County of Titus a special term of the Com-
County Commission Court
of Titus County, Texas was held in and for
Titus County, Texas at the Court Room thereof
in the town of Mt Pleasant on the 1st day
of July 1898. Presiding Leon F. Rogers County
Judge Mr. J. DeLafield, J. S. Hearsey, E. G. Brown
and J. W. Ball Commissioners, G. B. Dickson
Sheriff and D. G. Williams County Clerk
which and when the following proceedings
were had to wit:

In the matter of the assessment July 1st 1898
of the First National Bank this day the Court
of Mt Pleasant Texas for year 1898 met as Board of Equali-
zation. It appearing
to the Court that the First National Bank of
Mt Pleasant had been duly notified and appeared
before the Court. The Court having examined
the same and heard the evidence. It is or-
dered by the Court that the assessment rendered
by said Bank being at \$45000.00 be and the same
is set at said amount and that the tax assessor
take the assessment at said value.

In the matter of the support July 1st 1898
of Mrs. Rebecca Gray — It is ordered by the
Court that Mrs.
Rebecca Gray be placed upon the Pauper list
and that she be placed in the custody of
William Coker for support and that Child
Cokers be allowed the sum of \$3⁰⁰ per month
from this day until further orders of Court
for her support and that drafts issue monthly
on the General County Fund for same.

In the matter of the support of C. H. Richards a pauper July 1st 1898
 It appearing to the court that C. H. Richards a pauper has been taken care of by D. C. Oliver since the 16th day of May 1898 It is therefore ordered by the court that said D. C. Oliver be allowed the sum of \$7⁰⁰ per month from June 16th 1898 for the support of said Richards and that draft issue to him on the General County fund monthly for said sum until further orders of the court

In the matter of the support of C. H. Richards a Pauper July 1st 1898
 It appearing to the court that C. H. Richards wishes to return to his old home between white oak & sheepen if helped in his support by the county. It is therefore ordered by the court that should said Richards return to his house that he be allowed the sum of \$5⁰⁰ per month for his support from date of his return to further orders of this court and that draft issue monthly on the General County fund to J. W. Wright to be appropriated for the support of said Richards

In the matter of the pay of the court shuff July 1st 1898
 It is ordered by the court that P. B. Rogers County Judge, W. J. Adair, J. S. Harper & J. O. Ball commissioners be allowed the sum of \$3⁰⁰ each for holding court at this term and that G. B. Dickson be allowed \$2⁰⁰ for waiting on this court and that draft issue on the General County fund for same

The business before the court having been disposed of it is ordered that court adjourn
