 maintenance of John Crane a hunter
 and that drafts be sent him monthly for same.

In the matter of leave of } September 21st 1898
 absence of County Judge } It is ordered by the
 Court that F. W. Rogers
 County Judge be granted 90 days leave of absence.

In the matter of per diem } September 21st 1898
 pay of Court & Sheriff } It is ordered by the
 Court that F. W. Rogers
 County Judge W. J. Delaplace & J. P. Harper Commissioners
 be allowed the sum of \$3⁰⁰ per day for holding this Court
 and that U. B. Dickson Sheriff be allowed \$2⁰⁰
 for waiting on this Court

The business before the Court having been disposed
 of it is ordered that Court adjourn.
