 It appearing to the Court that the surveys }
 Records of Otter County Texas were destroyed }
 by fire on the 2nd day of September 1895. that }
 there is no way of procuring the filed notes }
 of said surveys except from the General }
 Land office at Austin Texas, and that }
 said filed notes are very much needed in }
 said Otter County. It is therefore ordered }
 by the Court that said C. M. Hill be and }
 he is authorized and directed to purchase }
 books and transcribe the filed notes of }
 all surveys of Otter County and that the }
 Clerk of this Court issue a County warrant }
 on the General County fund for said sum }

In the matter of the application of O. M. Dabbs & Davis Bros for place and erect Electric light poles in the town of Mt Pleasant and adjacencies by the Court that the said O. M. Dabbs and Davis Bros - do have and are hereby granted the right and privilege to erect and place Electric light poles and Electric wires on and along the public streets, alleys and high ways of the town of Mt. Pleasant and repair and maintain those already erected - Provided that said poles and wires be so placed and erected as not to interfere or impair the free use of said streets, alleys and highways by the public and provided further that none of said poles shall be less than twenty five (25) feet long

In the matter of the application of J. W. Timmison for erect Telephone poles by the Court that J. W. Timmison do have and they are hereby granted the right and privilege of erecting and placing Telephone poles and wires on and along the public streets, alleys, and highways of the town of Mt Pleasant Texas and on and along all the public roads and highways of Titus County, Texas leading from and to the town of Mt Pleasant Provided that each of said poles shall

be at least 25 feet long and the wires placed on said poles shall be sufficiently high so as not to interfere with the passing of vehicles and provided further that said poles shall be so constructed and placed so the same shall not interfere with or impair the free use of said streets and public roads by the public -

In the matter of the application of Morris Greenspan to erect Telephone poles and maintain Telephone exchange

It is ordered by the Court that the said

Morris Greenspan

do have and he is hereby granted the right and privilege to erect and place telephone poles and wires on and along all of the public streets, alleys and highways in the town of Mt Pleasant Texas and on and along all of the public roads and highways leading to and from the town of Mt Pleasant and to maintain and repair those already erected by him - Provided each of said poles shall be at least 25 feet long and the wires and poles so placed that the same shall in no way interfere or impede the free use of said streets alleys and highways by the public -
