

## February Call Term 1900

The State of Texas Be it remembered that County of Titus a special Term of the Hon. County Commissioners Court of Titus County Texas held in and for said County at the Court House thereof on the 7<sup>th</sup> day of February 1900. Hon. P. H. Rogers County Judge of said County Presiding Present Mr. J. DeLafield, J. A. Bivens, F. E. McClintock and F. W. Masters Commissioners, G. T. Dickson Sheriff and S. W. Williams County Clerk when and where the following proceedings were had to wit:

In the matter of quorantining February 7<sup>th</sup> 1900 against Small pox whereat it appearing to the Court that Small Pox is in neighboring towns and Counties surrounding this County - Texas and that the said disease may be brought to Mt Pleasant and in said County - It is therefore ordered, adjudged and decreed by the Court that Dr. J. P. Mackew County Physician be and he is hereby authorized and directed to take charge of any and all cases of small pox that may come to Mt Pleasant or Titus County - To select some suitable place for Confinement - To supply tents or posthouses, supplies, select assistants, guards and perform all other duties that may be necessary in such cases.

In the matter of the paying February 7<sup>th</sup> 1900 pay of Court and Sheriff - It is ordered by the Court that P. H. Rogers, J. DeLafield, J. A. Bivens, F. E. McClintock and F. W. Masters be allowed \$3<sup>00</sup> each for holding this Court and that G. T. Dickson Sheriff be allowed two dollars for waiting on this Court and that drafts issue on the general County fund for same -
