made on the 28th day of June 1900 of this Court
requiring the Clerk of this Court to give

The State of Texas To the Honorable Commission-
County of Titus sioners Court of Titus
County, Texas. In accordance
with an order made at your May Term 1900,
ordering the County Surveyor to run, mark,
locate the south end of the Precinct line be-
tween nos. 450. Beginning at a post 4 miles

East of the courthouse in the town of Mt Pleasant and run to Big Cypress, did on the 24th day of May 1900. Proceeded to discharge that duty.

Beginning at said post located on the Joshua S. Heill M.R. Survey, thence south striking J.C. Kirby farm passing through the same about 150 yds East of his house & crossing the Mt Pleasant and Jefferson road a post on line Mr. P.L. from which a black oak bro. south 85° W. 9 yds. another bro. south 46° E. 14 yds. both Mr. P.L. and still S. to M.C. Rogers farm through said farm to the Mt Pleasant and Leach road leaving his house about 10 feet East of line a large stone on line from which a R.O. bro. N 2° W. 11 rs. Mr. P.L. and still south through said farm to J.W. Rogers farm and passing about 200 yds west of his house entering timber a R.O. Mr. P.L. running still about to Mr. Amosworths farm about 200 yds. west of his house and still south to Mrs. M. Elroy's farm passing through same about 1/4 mile west of timber and entering S.W. Dubois farm west of his house and entering B.W. Rust farm 200 yds East of house and still south crossing Cypress school house road branched a birch Mr. P.L. come to Mrs. M. Keale farm running East of her house 150 yds. come to Mt Pleasant and Cypress road at J.W. Ragans house a R.O. Mr. P.L. come to C.H. Williams horse lot 27 yds. west of his house come to Jack Coons farm in the edge of Cypress bottom come to north bank of Big Cypress a stake a minor oak to N. 35° W. 5 rs. Mr. P.L. done May 24th 25th 1900
