 of August 1900 at the Court Room  
 of the town of Mount Pleasant.  
 Presiding the Hon. P. G. Rogers County  
 Judge of said County Present W. J.  
 DeLafield, John A. Davis, T. E. McClendon  
 and O. T. Masters Commissioners,  
 G. B. Jackson Sheriff and D. G. Williams  
 County Clerk when and where the fol-  
 lowing proceedings were had to wit:

In the matter of the August 20<sup>th</sup> 1900  
 Tax Rolls for the year } This day came  
 on to be examined  
 the Tax Rolls presented by T. Evans Tax  
 assessor of Titus County Texas for the year  
 1900. It appearing to the Court that  
 the said T. Evans Tax Assessor has com-  
 pleted said Tax rolls for the year 1900 -  
 and that the same have been cor-  
 rected made - It is therefore ordered  
 by the Court that said Tax Rolls for  
 the year 1900 be and the same are  
 hereby approved and accepted - And  
 it is further ordered by the Court  
 that said T. Evans Tax Assessor of  
 Titus County Texas be allowed the sum  
 of \$425<sup>35</sup> for assessing the County Taxes  
 of Titus County Texas for the year 1900  
 The total state and County taxes being  
 \$1701392. = \$850.70 = 1/2 \$425<sup>20</sup> and that  
 draft issue to him for said sum of  
 \$425<sup>30</sup> on the General County, Road and  
 Bridge and Court House and Jail funds  
 the same to be paid out of the first  
 moneys collected on taxes for the year

1900 - It is further ordered by the court that W. Evans, Tax assessor be allowed the sum of \$3<sup>00</sup> for assessing the taxes of school districts nos. 1, 2, 3 & 6 for the year 1900 said sum to be paid, out of the taxes for said school districts nos 1, 2, 3 & 6. And that draft issue to the said W. Evans for same

In the matter of the account of S. K. Caldwell County Attorney for \$5<sup>00</sup> August 20<sup>th</sup> 1900  
 It is ordered by the court that S. K. Caldwell County Attorney be allowed the sum of \$5<sup>00</sup> for services in Lunney case of Ethel Lane - and that draft issue thereon the General County fund for same.

In the matter of the per diem pay of the Court and Sheriff August 20<sup>th</sup> 1900  
 It is ordered by the court that P. H. Rogers County Judge, W. J. Deaford, John H. Swineart, E. McClinton and C. V. Masters be allowed the sum of \$3<sup>00</sup> each for holding this Court and that G. B. Bickley be allowed \$2<sup>00</sup> for waiting on this Court and that draft issue on the General County fund for same.

The business before the Court having been disposed of it is ordered that Court adjourn until next regular term -
