\$2.00 ⁰⁰ and that draft issue to him on
the General County fund for said sum.

The business before the court having
been disposed of and the foregoing ³ min-
utes read and approved it is ordered
that Court adjourn until next regu-
lar term.

Entry in regard to the incorporation of
the Town of Mt Pleasant, Texas -
Whereas on the 17th day of September A.D.
1900 at an election duly held for the pur-
pose of determining whether or not the
Town of Mt Pleasant, Texas, should be
incorporated there were 43 votes cast for
incorporation and 18 votes against
incorporation as shown by the returns
of said election, and whereas said elec-
tion resulted in favor of incorporation
the returns of which was made to me
as the law requires on the 18th day of
September A.D. 1900 - Therefore I, P. K. Rogers,
County Judge of Titus County, Texas
hereby declare that the inhabitants of the
Town of Mt Pleasant, Texas, are fully
and legally incorporated for Municipal
purposes within the following boundaries
to wit: Beginning at a place $\frac{3}{4}$ of one
mile North of the court house in the town
of Mt Pleasant, Titus County, Texas -
Thence West $\frac{3}{4}$ of one mile to place - -
Thence South $1\frac{1}{2}$ miles to place - -
Thence East $1\frac{1}{2}$ miles to place -
Thence North $1\frac{1}{2}$ miles to place -
Thence West $\frac{3}{4}$ of one mile to the place
of beginning - P. K. Rogers County Judge
