 and where the following proceedings were had to wit

In the matter of proving vs. November 24<sup>th</sup> 1900  
 The bonds of Justice and vs. This day came on  
 Precincts Officers vs. to be examined the  
 following manner persons were directed  
 to said office on the 6<sup>th</sup> day of November  
 1900 - W. M. King, Commissioner of Precinct  
 No. Three (3) Cal Russell Commissioner of  
 Justice Precincts 485 - C. M. Dabb County  
 Clerk J. F. Wilkinson, District Clerk  
 Sam Green Sheriff, W. M. King Justice of the  
 Peace of Precinct No. 2, L. W. Young Justice of  
 the Peace of Precinct No. 2, J. H. Hignow Justice  
 of the Peace of Precinct No. 6, all of Tarrant  
 County, Texas. It appears to the Court that  
 said bonds are in proper form - that the  
 sureties on each of said bonds sufficient  
 it is therefore ordered by the Court that  
 each of said bonds be and are hereby ap-  
 proved and ordered recorded and that  
 the above named persons be and are  
 hereby authorized and directed to hold the  
 office to which they were elected for the next  
 two years -

In the matter of repairing bridges in this county November 24<sup>th</sup> 1900  
 It is ordered by the court that each Commissioner have all bridges repaired that may need the same in their respective Precincts and the clerk of this Court is authorized to issue draft for said repairs when the work is completed and receipts and order sent to said clerk by the Commissioner said drafts to issue on the Road and Bridge fund

In the matter of the account of G. B. Dickson Sheriff for \$26<sup>50</sup> November 24<sup>th</sup> 1900  
 It is ordered by the court that G. B. Dickson Sheriff be allowed the sum of \$26<sup>50</sup> for waiting on the District Court November Term 1900 ten days and for 6 loads of wood for Court House and that draft issue to him on the General County fund for same -

In the matter of the account of G. B. Dickson, Tax Collector for \$3<sup>00</sup> November 24<sup>th</sup> 1900  
 It is ordered by the court that G. B. Dickson be allowed the sum of \$3<sup>00</sup> for certifying to reports by County Clerk and that draft issue to him on the General County fund -

In the matter of the account of D. G. Williams for \$1<sup>50</sup> September 24<sup>th</sup> 1900  
 It is ordered by the court that D. G. Williams County Clerk be allowed \$1<sup>50</sup> for certifying to collectors reports and that draft issue on the General County fund for same.

In the matter of the per diem pay of Constable and Sheriff November 24<sup>th</sup> 1900  
 It is ordered by the court that P. H. Hogan County, Judge, M. J. Caffrey, J. B. Thomas, M. M. King and Cal Russell

be allowed the sum of \$3<sup>00</sup> each for holding  
this Court and that the Sheriff be allowed  
\$2<sup>00</sup> for waiting on this Court and that drafts  
issue for the same on the General County Fund  
The business before the Court having been  
disposed of it is ordered that Court adjourn  
until next regular term
