In the Matter of the Account Dec. 31st 1900
of Sam Porter Sheriff. It is ordered by
the Court that
Sam Porter Sheriff vs. and he is hereby
allowed \$135⁰⁰ for 6 cords of wood for the
Court house and Jail, and that Warrant
issue on the General County Fund
for same.

In the Matter of account of  Dec. 31st 1900
 J.B. Tennison Son  It is ordered by the
 Court that J.B. Tennison
 and Son, be allowed the sum of Two-thousand
 Dollars, in accordance with their sworn
 account filed herein for Wds. Lock Etc.
 and that warrant issue on the General
 County fund for same.

In the Matter of acct. of  Dec. 31st 1900
 G.M. Roberts Printer  This day it is ordered
 by the Court that G.M.
 Roberts be allowed Fifty Dollars for Stationery
 Publishing Treasurers report and 500 Complaints,
 and that warrant issue on the General
 County fund for same.

In the Matter of acct. of  Dec. 31st 1900
 W.M. King.  This day it is ordered
 by the Court that W.M.
 King be allowed Three Dollars for
 receiving and letting bridge over ditch
 on W.P. Pleasant and Clarksville Lubie
 road and that warrant issue on
 the Road and Bridge fund for same.

In the Matter of account of  Dec. 31st 1900
 G.B. Dickson, Jailor.  This day it is ordered
 by the Court that
 G.B. Dickson be allowed Sixty Five & 20/100 Dollars
 for taking care of, and boarding prisoners
 in jail from Nov. 12th 1900 to Dec. 31st 1900
 and that warrant issue on General County
 fund for same.

In the matter of acct.  Dec. 31st 1900. This day it is
 ordered by the Court that T.M.
 Tully publick wh he allowed \$2.00 for Wds. furnished as per acct
 filed herein, dated Dec. 31-1900. And that warrant issue on Gen
 County fund for same.

In the Matter of appointment of Constable for Precinct No. 3, Titus County Texas. Dec. 31st 1900.

This day it appeared to the Court that J. J. Martin, the duly elected Constable of precinct No. 3, Titus County Texas, has failed to make and file his official Bond as required by law, in the time required by law, the said office of Constable, of Precinct No. 3, Titus County is hereby declared vacant, whereupon the Court appointed Henry Davis, of said precinct, Constable of said precinct No. 3 Titus County Texas, and for his bond at five hundred Dollars, and he is given 20 days after adjournment of this court in which to file his bond.
