against Small Pox, and G. M. Roberts City  
Secretary, appeared for the Board of Aldermen  
and read the order passed by said Board  
which is in substance as follows, to-wit:  
"Jan. 12<sup>th</sup> 1901, "It is ordered by the Council  
that the sum of Two and 50/100 Dollars per  
day be paid out of the city Treasury to  
Titus County, Texas for the purpose of assist-  
ing in defraying the expense of maintain-  
ing a quarantine, and suppressing Small  
pox in Titus County, such sum to be  
paid until this order is revoked by  
the City Council";

It is therefore considered and ordered  
by the Court in full session convened  
that the County Physician, Dr. W. H. Blythe  
be and he is hereby authorized to  
declare and maintain Quarantine  
against Small Pox in Titus County  
until the further order of this Court  
herein.

 by the court, It is the order of the court

That the County health officer Dr. W. H. Blythe  
 continue to put up the yellow flag when-  
 ever and where ever he deems it necessary  
 and to notify the inmates of the place  
 where he so plants said yellow flag, that  
 the County will not feed them or become  
 responsible for their groceries, unless  
 they go to the Pest house, and to notify  
 them, the said inmates, that if they  
 disobey the flag, by going in and out  
 of the place where it is planted, and disre-  
 gard its purpose, they will be prosecuted  
 as the law directs.

 That County Judge P. H. Rogers,  
 W. J. Dellapfield, W. M. King and Cal. Turner  
 be and they are allowed \$4<sup>00</sup> each for 3 days

 for awaiting on Court, and that the

 Court It is ordered That Court do now  
 adjourn, until its next Regular Meeting.
