It is therefore ordered by the Court that the said applications be and they are hereby approved and granted.

In the Matter of the Acct. of Sam. Porter Sheriff, for Board of Prisoners } June 18 1901

 Sam. Porter Sheriff of Titus County, for the Board of prisoners and it appearing to the Court that said account is just and unpaid it is therefore ordered by the Court that said account be and the same is hereby allowed for the sum of Seventy Three & 00/100 Dollars.

for which the clerk will issue warrant on General County fund to cover same.

In the matter of Acct. of H.C. Thomas for letting & Receiving Bridge on Audys Creek } June 18 1901
 This day came on to be heard and examined the acct of H.C. Thomas Co. Com. for letting & Receiving Bridge on Audys Creek, 2 days. And it appearing to the court that said acct. is just and unpaid it is therefore ordered by the Court that said account be and the same is hereby allowed and the clerk will issue warrant on Road & Bridge fund for Six Dollars to cover same.

In the matter of Repairing Jail & Court house Windows } June 19-1901.
 It is ordered by the court, that Sam Porter Sheriff be and he is hereby authorized to have repaired the County Jail and the windows in the tower of the Court house and when repaired, the clerk will issue Warrant on his sworn statement, on Court house & Jail fund to cover the amounts shown in his, Sam Porter's, sworn statements of the Expense of said repairs.

In the matter of Perdiem of Court and Sheriff } June 19 1901
 It is ordered by the Court that P.H. Boyer Co. Judge be allowed \$3⁰⁰ and H.C. Thomas, Cal Russell, J. Dellafield and W.M. King be allowed \$3⁰⁰ each for 2 days service holding Court and that Sam Porter Sheriff be allowed \$4⁰⁰ for waiting on Court. for which Warrant may issue on Genl. Co. fund.

There being no further business before the court It is ordered that Court do now adjourn until July 8th 1901 when it shall meet as Board of Equalization
