 A.D. 1901. Present and presiding the
 Hon P H Rogers County Judge of Titus Co. Tex
 and in attendance W J McLaughlin,
 H C Thomas, Cal Russell and W M King
 County Commissioners of said County
 Sam Porter Sheriff and Ouitabk Clark
 of the County Court in for said Titus
 County, when the following proce-
 dings were had to-wit:

In the matter of the Tax assessment for 1901

July 8th 1901
 This day came
 on to be examined
 and adjusted, the assessments of Taxes
 of the parties named in an order entered
 of record at a former term of this court
 to-wit on the 18th day of June 1901. And
 it appearing to the Court that said parties
 are corporations so named in said
 order have been duly and legally
 cited to appear and show cause why
 their taxes, as rendered by them and
 their agents should not be raised.
 And the Court after hearing the evidence
 and argument of counsel is of the
 opinion that the following named
 persons and Corporations' assessments
 as rendered by them for Taxes for the
 year 1901, be and the same is adjusted
 as follows.

The St Louis SW Ry Co of Texas, on 20.07 miles
 of railway through said County, rendered
 by James Beattie but \$7500⁰⁰ be and the
 said assessment is raised to \$8500⁰⁰ per mile

In the Matter of the Petition of M.F. Brown
 for a change in Public Road.
 This the 8th day of July 1901. Came on
 to be heard the petition
 of M.F. Brown & 4 others
 for a change in the
 Road no 67 in said road between A.W.
 Holmes Resd. running W.W. to Franklin
 County line said change to begin about
 ten steps from where the bridge stands
 across Ripley Creek running south crossing
 the said Creek about 30 or 40 steps south
 of where said bridge is now situated
 Thence on land lines between S.J. Young
 & M.F. Brown to where said lines cross
 the old original Road. making said

change about the distance of two hundred yards. And the Court is of the opinion that said change should be and the same is granted.

There being no further business before the Court it is ordered that Court do now adjourn.

Order for an Election at Winfield

The State of Texas
County of Titus

A. Petition having been filed in my office signed by thirty residents of the Town of Winfield asking that an election be ordered to enable the qualified voters of the said town of Winfield to determine whether they will incorporate for free school purposes only as provided in article 616A of R.S. of 1895 as amended in chapter 45 acts of the 25th Legislature of the State of Texas, and being fully satisfied that said town comes within the provisions of the above article 616A as amended by the Twenty fifth Legislature.

Now therefore, I, P. H. Rogers, County Judge in and for Titus County, Texas, do hereby order an election to be held at Winfield, on Saturday, the 10th day of August, 1901, for the purpose of submitting the question to a vote of the people as to whether the territory of the proposed incorporation shall be incorporated for free school purposes only; said territory being described by metes and bounds as follows: - Beginning at S.W. corner of the 401 Blundell survey - Thence North to N.W. corner of said survey - Thence East to the S.S. Smith survey - Thence North to the Rachel White survey - Thence East Thence North to the J. Hall N.E. corner - Thence North with Okfus West Boundary line to the South Pope Bridge road - Thence West with said road to the Franklin County line - Thence South with the Franklin County line to Blundells Creek - Thence with the meanderings of said Creek to the place of beginning the name by which said incorporation is to be known if incorporated is to be
