



Sept Special Term 1901

Be it remembered that a special term of the Hon. County Commissioners Court of Titus County was begun and holden within and for said county at the Court house thereof in the town of Mt Pleasant, on the 2nd day of Sept. 1901. Present and presiding the Hon P.H. Rogers County Judge of Titus Co. Tex. and W.J. Delafield, H.C. Thomas, W.M. King and Cal Russell county commissioners of said county and in attendance Sam Porter Sheriff and our Tabb Clerk County Court Titus County Texas. whereupon the following proceedings were had to-wit:

In the matter of the Tax  Sept 2nd 1901.
 Rolls for the year 1901  This day came on to be examined the Tax rolls presented by V. Evans, Tax assessor of Titus County Texas, for the year 1901 and it appearing to the court that said V. Evans had completed the said rolls for 1901 and that the same are correctly made. It is therefore ordered by the court that said Tax rolls for year 1901 be and the same are hereby approved and accepted.

It is further ordered by the Court that V. Evans, Tax assessor aforesaid, be allowed Five hundred and Twenty One and ¹³/₁₀₀ Dollars for assessing the County Taxes of Titus County Texas for the year 1901, same being 5% of \$2000000.00 and 2 1/2% of \$169213. The assessed valuation of said Titus County; and that draft issue in his favor out of the General County Road & bridge and Court house and Jail funds for said amount of \$521.¹³/₁₀₀ to be paid out of the first Money collected on said rolls for the year 1901.

It is further ordered by the court that

V. Evans Tax assessor of said be allowed the sum of \$4²² for assessing the Taxes of the school Districts Nos. 1, 2, 3 & 6. for which let draft issue against the special fund of said school Districts in favor of said W. Evans.

In the matter of acct. of Sept 2, 1901
of H. C. Thomas Ad. Supt. } It is ordered by the
Court that H. C. Thomas
be allowed Ten Dollars for 5 days
letting and receiving bridges as Road
supervisor. Warrant ordered drawn
on Road & Bridge fund for same.

In the matter of Perchem } Sept 2, 1901
Pay of Court and Sheriff } It is ordered
by the Court
that P. H. Boyer, W. J. Dellafield, H. C. Thomas
W. M. King and Cal Bussel be allowed
\$3⁰⁰ each for one and that Sam Porter
sheriff be allowed \$2⁰⁰ for one day Court
service and let warrant issue on
General County fund for same.
