 Court of Titus County Texas was begun  
 and holden at the Court house of said  
 County in the town of Mt Pleasant, on  
 the 27 day of January 1902. Present and  
 presiding the Hon. F. H. Rogers County Judge  
 of said County and W. J. Dellfield, Callumell  
 and H. C. Thomas County Commissioners and  
 Sam Porter Sheriff and Ouitabh. C. Clark  
 whereupon the following proceedings  
 were had to-wit:

In the matter of hiring ~~of~~ January 27, 1902  
 County Convicts ~~of~~ This day came on  
 to be considered the  
 matter of letting or hiring the County  
 Convicts and it appearing to the Court  
 that E. A. Tigers offers a reasonable price  
 for the hire of all the County Convicts  
 which are convicted in the several  
 Justice precincts in the County also  
 for those convicted in the County Court.  
 It is therefore ordered by the Court  
 that all the County convicts of said  
 County be and they are hereby let  
 or hired to E. A. Tigers at the rate  
 of Five Dollars per month each  
 to be paid by said Tigers at the  
 end of each month. The said Tigers  
 to give Bond for each Convict as  
 same is delivered to him.

In the Matter of J.D. Smith a Pauper } 3 July 27, 1902  
 This day is ordered by the Court that J.D. Smith a Pauper, be and he is hereby allowed Three + 59<sup>00</sup> Dollars for support of himself until the February Term of this Court and warrant is ordered drawn on General County fund for said amount in favor of J.D. Smith.

In the Matter of } 3 January 27, 1902  
 Transferring funds } It is ordered by the Court that County Treasurer J.M. Crooks, transfer from the Court house and jail fund, Four hundred Dollars, to the Jury fund.

In the Matter of the } 3 January 27, 1902  
 Pardon of Court Sheriff } It is ordered by the Court that P.H. Rogers a Judge, W.J. DeLoe a H.C. Thomas and Ed. Russell be each allowed \$3<sup>00</sup> per day for holding this term of Court which convened and adjourned on same day. And it is further ordered that Sam Porter Sheriff be allowed Two Dollars for waiting on Court, and that warrant issue on General County fund for same.
