

September Special Term, A.D. 1902.

Be it remembered that a Special Term of the Honourable Commissioners Court of Titus County Texas, was begun and holden within and for Titus County Texas, on the Second (2nd) day of September A.D. 1902. Present and presiding W. J. Delafield Commissioner for Precinct No. One H. C. Thomas Commissioner for Pre. No. 2 W. M. King Commissioner for Pre. No. 3 and C. C. Thomas Commissioner for Pre. No. 4. The Hon. P. H. Rogers County Judge of Titus County being absent on account of sickness, W. J. Delafield presided over said Court, and in attendance Sam Porter Sheriff and Ottobek Clark. Whereupon the following proceedings were had to-wit:

In the Matter of the Tax ~~Rolls~~ September 2nd 1902
 Rolls for year 1902. ~~Rolls~~ This day, came on to be examined the Tax Rolls presented by V. Evans, Tax Assessor for the year 1902, and it appearing to the Court that said V. Evans, has completed said rolls for 1902, and that the same are correctly made. It is therefore ordered by the Court that said Tax rolls for the year 1902, be and the same are thereby approved and accepted. It is further ordered by the Court that said V. Evans aforesaid be allowed Five hundred Twenty seven and 27/100 (\$527²⁷/₁₀₀) Dollars for assessing the County Taxes for said County, for the year 1902, same being 5% of \$2000000.⁰⁰ and 2 1/2% of \$218275⁰⁰. The assessed valuation of said Titus County Texas, and that Warrant issue on the Road & Bridge, Court House and Jail and General County funds in his favor in the proportional part as belongs to said funds of the \$527²⁷/₁₀₀. and that the same be paid out of the first taxes collected

on said rolls for the year 1902.

It is further ordered by the court that V. Evans Tax Assessor aforesaid be allowed the sum of \$4.48 for assessing the Taxes of the School Districts No. 1, 2, 3, 5 & 6. for which let draft issue against the special funds of said School District in favor of said V. Evans.

It is ordered by the court after examining same that the following accounts against Titus County be and they are hereby allowed, and Warrant ordered drawn on Road & Bridge fund to cover same to wit:

To 3 Days letting & receiving Bridges 6⁰⁰

Titus County To W. M. King Co Commr. Dr
To 17 Days letting & rec. Bridges 14⁰⁰

It is ordered by the Court that each member of the Court present be allowed \$3⁰⁰ per day for one day, and that said dates be allowed \$2⁰⁰ for waiting on Court one day, and Warrant may issue for same.
