

The State of Texas Be it remembered that
County of Titus of a special term of the
Honorable County Commissioners
Court of Titus County Texas was begun and
held within and for the County of
Titus, at the Court house thereof in the town
of M. Pleasant Texas, on the 15th day of
January AD 1903, present and presiding
The Hon P H Rogers County Judge, Geo F.
Hay, A. M. Scott, W. M. King and J. Sanderson
County Commissioners, Sam T. Stoff Sheriff
and Omrah County Clerk, whereupon
the following proceedings were had
to wit;

In the Matter of Incorporating January 15-1903
the vote and election of M. Pleasant a petition
result of City election having been filed
with the County Judge
of Titus County Texas signed by 100 property
tax payers of the town of M. Pleasant, petitioning
the court to order an election in the city
limits of the Incorporated town of the town
of M. Pleasant, to determine whether or not
said incorporation shall be abolished.
And the County Judge having ordered an
election in accordance with said petition
to be held in said town of M. Pleasant on the 12th
day of January AD 1903. Whereupon on this
the 15th day of January 1903 the court proceeded
to open the polls and count said vote
and find that there were 84 votes cast in
favor of maintaining said incorporation and
56 votes in favor of abolishing said incorporation
and that there were 30 votes majority for
the maintenance of said incorporation
It is therefore ordered that said election
resulted in favor of incorporation.
