

Be it remembered that on this the 9th day of April AD 1903 there was begun and holden a special term of the Honorable County Commissioners Court of Titus County Texas. at the Court house thereof in the town of Mockersburg Texas present and presiding the Honorable J. H. Rogers County Judge of said County, J. M. Hays, J. M. Scott, W. M. King, and J. Southern and county Commissioners of said County, Sam. Porter Sheriff and Oscar A. Hunt Clerk whereupon the following proceedings were had to wit:

In the matter of canvassing the returns and declaring the result of an election held in and throughout Titus Co. on the 4th of April¹⁹⁰³ for the election of Trustees of the various school districts of Titus County Texas. On this day April the 9th AD. 1903 came on to be considered and counted the vote cast in the several school districts in and throughout Titus County on the fourth day of April 1903. for the election of Trustees for said districts for the public schools of said County and it appearing to the Court after close count and examination of the returns of said election that the same was properly returned, and that the following named persons received the highest vote for the respective precincts it is therefore ordered by the Court that they are hereby declared elected Trustees for their respective precincts as follows to wit:

 the same is hereby allowed to each P. H. Hayes
 G. M. Scott A. T. Hays W. W. King & J. Southland for
 holding this term of court and that Sam
 Porter be and he is allowed \$2⁰⁰ for waiting
 on the court, and the clerk is allowed
 nothing for his services, and clerk will
 issue warrant on General County fund
 to cover same.

There being no further business before the
 court it is ordered that court do now adjourn.
