

Board of Equalization 1903.

Be it remembered that on this the 15th day of June Ad. 1903 there was begun and helden a special term of the County Commissioners Court, which said court met as a board of Equalization in the town of Mt Pleasant, Texas at the court house theroy in Titus County Texas Present and presiding the Hon W H Rogers County Judge, Geo T Hays, H M Scott, H M King and J S Southerculand commissioners of said County, and Sam Barker Sheriff and Onward County Clerk. Whereupon the following proceedings were had to-wit:

In the matter of pending of June 17th 1903

Court and \$2⁰⁰ per day for Sheriff for
which let warrants issue.

the court it is ordered that Court
take recess until July 7th 1903 at
which time it will reassemble as
board of Equalization
