

Board of Equalization 1903.

Be it remembered that on this the 15th day of June A.D. 1903 there was begun and holden a special term of the County Commissioners Court, which said court met as a Board of Equalization in the town of W. Pleasant, Texas at the court house thereof in Titus County Texas Present and presiding the Hon W. H. Rogers County Judge, Geo. F. Wags, H. M. Scott, H. M. King and J. S. Southerland, Commissioners of said County, and Sam Porter Sheriff and Omitash County Clerk, whereupon the following proceedings were had to-wit:
