

The State of Texas, J. M. Peterson, Texas, Sept 30<sup>th</sup> 190<sup>x</sup>  
 Titus County Whereas, an election was duly  
 held in the town or village of  
 Bookville on the 6<sup>th</sup> day of September 190<sup>x</sup>, to deter-  
 mine whether the territory after described territory  
 should be incorporated for free school purposes only,  
 and returns of said election duly made, and the ap-  
 pearing from said returns that there were cast at  
 said election 56 votes for "Incorporation" and 18 votes  
 for "No Incorporation" It is therefore adjudged that  
 said election resulted in favor of said incorporation.  
 Therefore, I, J. W. Rogers County Judge of Titus County,  
 Texas, do hereby declare the inhabitants of said  
 territory herein after described as duly incorporated  
 for free school purposes only, said incorporation  
 to be named The Bookville Independent School Dis-  
 trict. The said Independent School District con-  
 tains a population of 200 inhabitants, and the terri-  
 tory so incorporated is described by metes and bounds  
 as follows: Beginning at a stake in the Texas and Morris  
 Co. line where said line crosses the N. 73. line of a  
 20 1/2 Acre tract of land out of the Joan P. Langston  
 survey, said tract owned by W. A. Wright, thence  
 west with the N. 73. line of said Wright tract 800 mrs.,  
 a stake in the E. 73. line of the J. M. Bickerstaff survey.  
 Thence north with the said E. 73. line of the said Bicker-  
 staff survey 1000 mrs. to the N. E. corner of the same, a  
 stake in the S. 73. line of the W. D. Smith survey -  
 Thence west with the said N. 73. line of the said Bickerstaff  
 survey 735 mrs. to the N. W. corner of the same. Thence  
 south with the N. 73. line of the said Bickerstaff survey  
 500 mrs. to the E. corner of the same, the S. E. corner  
 of the W. D. Taylor survey. Thence west with the S. 73.  
 line of the said W. D. Taylor survey 1345 mrs. to the  
 S. W. corner of the same, a stake in the E. 73. line of the  
 E. 73. King survey. Thence north with the E. 73. line of  
 the King survey 700 mrs. to the N. E. corner of the same -  
 Thence west with the N. 73. line of the King survey to  
 the N. W. corner of the same. Thence north with the  
 N. 73. line of the Bellisapie survey 1870 mrs. thence  
 L. corner, a stake in S. M. Gandy's S. 73. line,  
 Thence north with the E. 73. line of the Bellisapie  
 survey 305 mrs. to the N. E. corner of the same

Thence west 700 rrs. with the N. 73. line of the  
 Gillespie survey to the N. W. Corner of the same  
 Thence south with the N. 73. line of the Gillespie  
 survey 625 rrs. a stake in the N. E. Corner of the  
 S. M. Gaughey survey 525 rrs. his S. W. Corner -  
 also the S. E. corner of the Shoe Sattler slide survey  
 thence west with the S. 73. line of the Patterson  
 survey 159 x rrs. the N. W. Corner of the W. C. Ratter  
 survey - thence south with the N. 73. line of the  
 Ratter 134 x rrs. his S. W. Corner. Thence west with  
 the N. 73. line of the Seth Pryor survey 112 x rrs. his  
 N. W. Corner. Thence south with the N. 73. line of the  
 said Pryor survey 134 x rrs. his S. W. corner. -  
 Thence East with the S. 73. line of the said Pryor survey  
 411 rrs. N. P. Sullivan's N. W. corner. Thence with Sullivan's  
 N. 73. line 121 rrs. his extreme S. E. corner. Thence south  
 with the S. 73. line of a small survey in the name of  
 W. C. Willson 240 rrs. his S. E. corner. Thence west  
 with the said Willson's S. 73. line and the N. 73. line  
 of the Wm Burn survey post Willson's S. W. corner  
 532 rrs. in all a stake on the N. 73. line of the same  
 survey the N. W. corner of a tract of land now owned by S. C.  
 Dobb and known as the "Red place". Thence south with  
 the division line between the said Red place and  
 a tract out of the said survey known as the "Jack  
 Moon place" 134 x rrs. a stake in the S. 73. line of the  
 S. 73. line of the said Burn survey 260 rrs. west of the  
 N. E. corner of the G. W. Shuck survey. Thence East with  
 the S. 73. line of the Burn survey 260 rrs. the N. E. corner  
 of the G. W. Shuck survey, a stake. Thence south  
 with Shuck's S. 73. line 905 rrs. a stake in said line  
 the S. W. corner of the S. C. Beasley survey. Thence  
 East with the S. 73. line of the Beasley survey post  
 the S. E. corner of the same it being the S. W. corner  
 of the Da Kirk survey 2597 rrs. a stake in the S. 73.  
 line of the O. Kirk survey, at the N. W. corner of a tract  
 of land once owned by Lawson Johnson. Thence south  
 with the division line between the said Lawson  
 Johnson tract and tract once known as the David  
 Yanney tract, now owned by T. J. Triggell, and  
 on south with the N. 73. line of the J. E. Johnson  
 tract, John P. Denney's tract and J. W. Thomas's tract all  
 out of the Geo. Clapham survey 2080 rrs. in all

pair J. W. Brown's S.W. corner. Thence East with Brown's  
 S.W. line 1500<sup>70</sup>. to his S.E. corner the N.W. corner of a tract  
 once owned by J. L. Homer. Thence south with the N.W.  
 line of the said Homer tract and the N.W. line of another  
 tract of land owned by the pair J. W. Brown 930<sup>70</sup> to  
 Brown's S.W. corner. Thence East with Brown's S.W. line  
 1380<sup>70</sup>. Brown's S.E. corner and J. E. Johnson's N.E. corner  
 Thence south with Johnson's S.W. line and J. Southland's  
 N.W. line 448<sup>70</sup>. Southland's S.W. corner. Thence  
 East with Southland's S.W. line to his S.E. corner and  
 on with the S.W. line of the A. B. Galoupe tract past  
 his S.E. corner and on with Tom Davis's tract 2150<sup>70</sup>.  
 in all Davis's S.E. corner. Thence north with Davis's S.W.  
 line past his N.E. corner and on with Lee Smith's S.W.  
 line 1760<sup>70</sup>. in all Smith's N.E. corner a stake on the  
 bank of Boggy Creek. Thence East with the S.W. line  
 of a tract of land owned by J. F. Martin and known as  
 the John Davis place 800<sup>70</sup>. a stake on the Oliver  
 and Morris Co. line. Thence North with the said County  
 line 2810<sup>70</sup>. past the N.W. line of the N. P. Seate  
 Survey and at 1300<sup>70</sup>. farther on Mrs. McDonald's N.W.  
 line, and at 1344<sup>70</sup>. farther on Turner Land's N.W. line  
 and at 1310<sup>70</sup>. farther on. or 9264<sup>70</sup>. the place of  
 beginning. This order made and entered upon the re-
