Wm. Cantrell on the Pauper list.

This day came on to be considered the application to place Wm. Cantrell on the pauper list of Citrus County, Texas, and it appearing to the Court that said Cantrell is in indigent circumstances, it is ordered by the Court that he be, and he is hereby placed on the pauper list of Citrus County, Texas. It is further ordered by the Court that he be allowed the sum of \$7.50 per month for his

support and maintenance, and the clerk of this court is hereby authorized to issue warrant to cover same on the 15th day of each month until otherwise ordered by the court.
