

Board of Equalization July 5th 1906

Be it remembered that on this the 5th day of July 1906, there was begun & holden a special session of the Commissioners Court of Tarrant Co. Texas. Said session was held as a Board of Equalization in the town of Mt. Pleasant, Co. of Tarrant, State of Texas, present & presiding, Sec. H. Caldwell, Co. Judge, Geo. H. Wynn, Geo. P. Smith, J. W. McClinton & M. C. Harting Commissioners, Sarge Porter Sheriff & W. M. Daugh Co. Clerk, whereupon the following proceedings among others were had to-wit:
