The State of Texas ~~Be it~~ remembered that a Special County of Term of the Com. Commission and Court of Other County Texas was held in and for said County at the Courthouse thereof in the town of M. Pleasant on the 18th day of March 1908 Hon. Sch. B. Caldwell County Judge of said County presiding - Present W. H. Wood and J. P. Denney Commissioners, W. D. Anderson Sheriff and P. H. Branch County Clerk who and where the following proceedings were had to wit:

In the matter of Small pox March 18-1908

On this day the Commission
Court of Other County Texas in joint session with the City Council of M. Pleasant
considered that the small pox existing as it exist in M. Pleasant and Other County at this time - concluded that the preservation of the health of the citizens of the town and County creates a necessity of establishing a quarantine to keep individuals affected with small pox confined and separated from the public and determined that it exist from the date of this quarantine as designated by the rules of medical contagion as promulgated by the State Health Officer. It is further concluded by the City Council and Court that the expense incurred by such quarantine except of salary of City and County Health officers - in the proportion of $\frac{1}{3}$ by the City and $\frac{2}{3}$ by the County - shall therefore be ordered and deemed by the Commissioners and Court -

It is ordered by the Court that Sch. B. Caldwell County Judge W. H. Wood and J. P. Denney be allowed two each for holding this Court.

The business before the Court having been disposed of it is ordered that Court adjourn -
