proceedings were had to wit:

In the matter of Small pox } March 18-1908

On this day, The Commissioners  
Court of Tlaxcala County Texas in  
joint session with the City Council of Mt Pleasant Texas  
Considering that the Small pox situation as it exist  
in Mt Pleasant and Tlaxcala County at this time - Concluded  
that the preservation of the health of the Citizens of the  
town and County creates a necessity of establishing a  
quarantine to keep individuals affected with Small pox  
confined and separated from the public and declared that  
it is not from the dated kind of quarantine as designated  
by the rules governing contagion as promulgated by the  
State health officer. It is further concluded by the said  
Council and Court that the expenses incurred by such  
quarantine except salary of City and County health  
officers - in the proportion of 1/3 by the City and 2/3  
by the County - be therefore approved and deemed  
by the Commissioners Court -

It is ordered by the Court that S. Caldwell County Judge  
W. W. Wood and J. P. Denny be allowed two each for holding this Court

The business before the Court having been disposed of  
it is ordered that Court adjourn -
