In the matter of the petition of G. H. Haygood & 56 others for stock law election July 17th 1908
 This day came on to be heard the petition of G. H. Haygood and 56 others citizens of Justice Precinct No. 4, T. H. County, Texas for an order of Court ordering and election to be held in said Justice Precinct No. 4. to determine whether or not a general stock law shall prevail in said precinct - which is bounded as follows - - South of Cookville to the north boundary line of Hickory Hill Beat. East and west from Morris County line to the East boundary line of Beat No. 1. Then with said line to the south boundary line of the Argo Beat the Liberty Hill road until said road intersects with the Cookville and Ellie Bridge Road Jerry Lilly's and then north with the Ellie Bridge Road to Ellie Bridge on Whitlock and East with road then to the Morris County line and with said line to the North East corner of the Hickory Hill Beat.
 It appearing to the Court that said petition is in proper form and has the required number of names as signers. It is therefore ordered by the Court that said petition be granted, and that said election be held in said Justice Precinct No. 4, T. H. County, Texas on the 29th day of August A. D. 1908 at the voting box of said Precinct to wit Cookville -
