In the matter of an election } September 18th 1908
 held in School District No. 5 } This day the Court pro-
 Tarrant County Texas. } ceeded to count the
 vote of an election held
 at Pleasant Hill in School District No. 5. to deter-
 mine whether or not a tax of (20) twenty cents on the (\$100.00)
 One hundred dollar worth of property will be levied
 for school purposes in School District No. 5. -
 And it appearing to the Court that a 2/3 Majority
 of all votes cast at said election were in favor
 of taxation. It is therefore ordered by the Court
 that there shall be levied upon the property
 in said School District No. 5. a tax of (20) twenty
 cents on each \$100.00 worth of property for the year
 1908 and that the same shall be collected for school
 purposes -

In the matter of purchasing school house bonds school district no. 12

September 18th 1908

This day I came to be examined the \$1200.00 bonds issued by common school District no. 12. Tithus County Texas for school house building. It appearing to the Court that there is money on hand in the Permanent school fund of Tithus County, Texas that may be invested. It is therefore ordered by the Court that the sum of \$1200.00 of the Permanent School fund of Tithus County, Texas be invested in the purchase of \$1200.00 bonds issued by Common school District no. 12. Tithus County Texas - for school house building. It is further ordered by the Court that E. V. Broadstreet Treasurer of Tithus County Texas take into custody the bonds so purchased and to credit Common School District no. 12. as provided by law -

In the matter of the account of J. J. Reese Tax assessor of Tithus County for \$885.⁰⁰

September 18th 1908

This ordered by the Court that J. J. Reese Tax assessor of Tithus County Texas be allowed the sum of \$885.⁰⁰/100 for assessing taxes for the year 1908 - and that the clerk of this Court issue warrant to him for said amount less the amount of warrants heretofore issued to him as part payments on said sum -

In the matter of the account of J. J. Reese Tax assessor of Tithus County Texas for \$25.⁰⁰

September 18th 1908

This ordered by the Court that J. J. Reese tax assessor of Tithus County Texas be allowed the sum of \$25.⁰⁰ for furnishing 25% off rendition from tax sheets in July 1907 - and that the clerk of this Court is authorized and directed to issue warrant to him for the same -

 County Texas - } that there are a great

 which is situated in Titus County Texas, were recorded
 at Chamaville Red River County Texas before the or-
 ganization of Titus County Texas which was in the
 year 1845 - has never been transcribed from the records
 of said Red River County Texas to Titus County - And
 that it is necessary that said deeds should be transcrib-
 ed in order to perfect titles - It is therefore ordered
 by the Court that O. B. Branch County Clerk of Titus
 County be and he is hereby authorized and directed
 to transcribe the deeds from said Red River County
 to Titus County Texas as the law directs -
