

In the matter of declaring result of stock law election in Justice Precinct No. One - September 30th 1908
In the matter of carrying the returns of an election held in Justice Precinct No. One
 One Texas County case held on September 26th, 1908. To determine whether or not horses, mules, jacks, jennets and cattle shall be permitted to run at large in said precinct, by J. Caldwell County Judge of Texas County, Texas in the presence of Sam Porter Justice of the Peace for said County and P. B. Branch County Clerk of said County. It appearing from said returns that 344 votes were cast at said election - 132 of which votes were cast for the stock law and 211 of which votes were cast against the stock law. The election is declared carried against the stock law in said Justice Precinct No. 1. Texas County Texas.

In the matter of declaring result of stock law election in Justice Precinct No. 2. September 30 1908
In the matter of carrying the returns of an election held in Justice Precinct No. 2. of Texas County Texas on September 26th 1908.
 To determine whether or not horses, jacks, jennets and cattle should be permitted to run at large in said Justice Precinct No. 2. Texas County Texas by J. Caldwell County Judge of Texas County Texas in the presence of Sam Porter Justice of the Peace of Precinct No. 1. of said County and P. B. Branch County Clerk of said County. It appearing from said returns that 74 votes were cast at said election - 41 of which said votes were cast for the said stock law and 33 of which said votes were cast against the stock law. It appearing from said returns that there were 8 more votes cast for the stock law than against the stock law in said Precinct at said election. By virtue of Authority vested in me by Law I declare that the said election was in favor of the stock law in said Precinct described as follows: Beginning at a corner where the County line of the Counties of Texas and Franklin intersect White oak Creek. Thence South with said line to Park Bridge road. Thence with said road nearly East

to a well in said road and known as the Chapman well
 said well being about 5 1/2 miles N.W. of the town of
 Mt Pleasant Texas. Thence north to White oak creek -
 Thence with the meanderings of said creek to place of
 beginning - And it shall be unlawful for any of
 said stock to run at large in said Precinct described
 as aforesaid after 30 days of September 30th 1908 -
 the said 30th day of September being the date on
 which I issued my proclamation declaring the result of
 said election etc. And caused the same to be posted
 on the Courthouse door of the Courthouse in Titus
 County Texas in the town of Mt Pleasant Texas

 that 67 votes were cast at said election - 26 of which
 votes were cast for the stock law and 36 of which votes
 were cast against said stock law - It further appear-
 ing that there were 10 votes more cast against the stock
 law than for the stock law - in said Justice Precinct
 No. 6 - I therefore by virtue of Authority vested in me
 by law - declare that the said election resulted against
 the stock law in said Justice Precinct No. 6 -
