a Pauper.

In the Matter of County Depository.

Riddle County Judge of said County of Titus advertise in some weekly news paper printed in said Court each week for twenty days for bids for the County depository and each and every bid must conform to law regarding such bids.

On this day came on to be considered the matter of sending two members of the court to investigate the pauper and convict farm at Lindale, and get such information as may be beneficial to the court in establishing a like farm in Titus County, and the Court decided to send W. E. Riddle and J. W. Vest. It is therefore ordered and adjudged by the court that said Riddle and Vest. visit said farm and report to the court such information as they see fit. and that the expense of the trip be paid out of the General County fund of Titus County Texas.
