In the matter of the petition of Earnest Traylor et als.  
for a special school Tax in District No Yancey School.

Jan 20th, 1909, on this day came on to be heard the petition of Earnest Traylor and et als for a special school tax of 20 cents on the One Hundred dollars worth of property in School District No Yancey School for the purpose of supplementing the State appropriation. It appearing to the court that said petition is in proper form and is signed by a majority of the freeholder of the said District. It is therefore ordered that said petition be granted and that an election be held at Yancey School house on the 27th day of Feb. A. D. 1909, in said School District to determine whether or not a special tax of 20 cents on the One Hundred Dollars worth of property should be levied in said School District No. for the purpose of supplementing the State Appropriation. It is further ordered that A. Smelser, Fred Traylor and Bill Filand are appointed to hold said election and the Sheriff of Titus County is hereby directed and required to give notice of said election by posting three notices in said School District No. no two of which shall be at the same place.
