

Be it remembered that on July 26th 1910, there was begun and holden within and for the county of Titus a, special term of the Hon. Commissioners court with W E. Riddle County Judge, Presiding, R. B. White, J. W. Vest, A. O. Brown and J. J. Smith commissioners, W. D. Sanders sheriff and A. S. Mitchell County Clerk present when the following proceedings were had to-wit:

In the Matter of declaring the result of a Special Election to elect a State Senator.

July 26th 1910. On this day came on to be examined the result of a special Election for the purpose of electing a State Senator, whereupon the court found from the returns of said election that L. B. Reach received 1358 votes and J. L. Ratliff received 468 votes at said election.

In the matter of the Petition of J. W. Price et als.

July 26th A. D. 1910. On this day came on to be considered the petition of J. W. Price et als for change in Boundaries of Cypress School Dist No 25 and Lange's Chappel District No. 33 The petition being an oral one and stating that in the year 1910 Lang's Chappel School Patrons obtained an order from the Commissioners Court Cutting J. W. Price's farm off from Cypress and putting it in Lange's Chappel District without the knowledge or consent of the said J. W. Price and also that the said J. W. Price is closer to Cypress and has better roads, and that it is his desire to remain in cypress Dist. It is therefore ordered by the court that that part of the order passed by the court last year be rescinded and that J. W. Price farm be placed back in Cypress Dist.

Contract with Austin Bros. for Steel Bridge.

July 26, 1910. On this day came on to be considered the matter of letting contract to build a steel bridge across white oak creek on Black's Crossing, and it appearing to the court that said bridge is very badly needed, and that it will be necessary to build a steel bridge, therefore sealed bids were received for the contract of building said bridge and the lowest bid received was from Austin Bros, of Dallas, for \$1400.00 which bid was received by the court to build a 65 feet span across said creek according to plans and specifications.
