

Be it remembered that on Oct 5th A. D. 1910 there was begun and holden within and for Titus County, Texas a special term of the Hon. Commissioners Court with W. E. Riddle County Judge Presiding, Present Commissioners R. B. White, J. W. Vest, A. O. Brown and J. J. Smith, A. S. Mitchell County Clerk, W. D. Sanders Sheriff, when the following Proceeding were had:

In the matter of letting contract to get up delinquent Tax rolls. Oct 5th. A. D. 1910, on this day came on to be considered the matter of letting contract for delinquent Tax Rolls, and the Court hearing the proposition of Adele Whittle of Austin, Tex wherein she agrees to compile the delinquent taxes of Titus County from the year 1885 to 1909 inclusive for the sum of \$300.00, and it appearing to the Court that Miss Whittle is in position to do this work and that the price is reasonable, It is therefore ordered adjudged and decreed by the court that she be awarded the contract of compiling the delinquent taxes according to the terms of the written contract signed by both the Court and Miss Whittle. Which said Contract is as follows:

Contract entered into by Titus County and Adele Whittle, Titus County being known as the party of the first part and Adele Whittle as party of the second part.

The said party of the first part this day enters into contract with the said party of the second part, and agrees to pay the said party of the second part the sum of Three Hundred dollars for the work described below:

The said party of the second part agrees to compile the delinquent taxes of Titus County from the year 1885 to 1909 (Inclusive) preparing all taxes where the assessor has assessed the same on abstracts together, or abstract land and town property under one tax, giving each tract or lot its prorata of Tax, giving all totals and the penalty thereon, show up all double assessments, render known and unknown and being carried on the Assessors Rolls of Titus County from year 1885, show all cancellations and forfeitures of abstract lands, as shown by the records of the general land office of Texas, show where surveys conflict in this County with the adjoining Counties, give complete description of all lands and lots for collection of said delinquent taxes by the County Attorney and Tax Collector, report all lots in numerical order according to lots, blocks and divisions, and subdivisions. Also to report All abstracts in Alphabetical and numerical order, according to years.

In payment thereof the said party of the second part agrees to accept the sum of three hundred dollars after said record has been passed on by the Commissioners Court of Titus County
