In the matter of allowing accounts

In the matter of approving official Bonds

Dec. 2nd. 1910. on this day came on to be considered the matter of approving official bonds of the following named parties which bonds are in due form and are good for the amounts given. It is therefore ordered that said bonds be and the same are in all things approved by the court. T. B. Brown As Justice of the Peace Precinct No. 4. G. B. Diek on State and County Bonds as Assessor of Taxes for Titus County. C. C. Cleland State Bond as Collector of Taxes for Titus County.

In the Matter of Appointing Constable Precinct No. 8 Titus County Texas.

Official Bond of C. C. Cleland.

Dec. 24th A. D. 1910, On this day came on to be considered the matter of approving County Bond of C. C. Cleland as Collector of taxes for Titus County, Texas, and it appearing to the court that said bond conforms to law and is amply secured. It is therefore ordered that said bond be and the same is hereby approved.

In the matter of Paupers.

Dec. 24th 1910, on this day came on to be considered the applications of Willie Mickie and Mrs. Sellie Brookshire to be placed on the pauper list. and after considering the said applications. It is ordered by the court that Willie Mickie be allowed \$5.00 per month and it is specially understood that the county pays no other bills for her, and the said Mrs. Sellie Brookshire is allowed the sum of \$5.00 for three months, and it is further ordered by the court that Jno. Smith a Pauper who is drawing \$6.00 per month be allowed only \$5.00 per month.

In the matter of building hitching racks.

Dec. 24th 1910, on this day came on to be considered the matter of building hitching racks around the long panels of the Court yard fence, and it appearing to the court that a necessity exist for such fences as people have no place to hitch horses. It is therefore ordered that said fence be build and that the cost of same be presented to the city of Mt. Pleasant, for payment.

In the matter of Pauper

Dec. 24th 1910, on this day came on to be considered the matter of sending old cripple negro to Taylor Texas, and it appearing to the court that he is in bad condition, and will have to be placed on pauper list if he is not sent and away and that it would be cheaper to send him away than to provide for him here. It is therefore ordered and adjudged that scrip be issued for sufficient amount to send him to Taylor. Texas.

In the matter of appointing Constable Pre. No. 3.

Dec. 24th A. D. 1910, on this day came on to be considered the matter of appointing Constable Pre. No. 3 and it appearing that Geo. Blalock is in no way disqualified and that he will make a good constable. It is therefore ordered and adjudged that he be and he is hereby appointed Constable aforesaid and his bond is set at the amount of \$500.00

In the matter of allowing accounts.

Dec 24th A. D. 1910, on this day came on to be considered the matter of allowing accounts, and it appearing to the court that it would be better to allow accounts only at regular meetings of the court. It is therefore ordered that accounts will be allowed hereafter only at regular terms.
