

Be it remembered that on April 3 A. D. 1911 there was begun and holden within and for the County of Titus a special term of the Hon. Commissioners Court within and for said County, with W. E. Riddle County Judge Presiding, Present R. B. White, A. O. Brown H. W. West and R. J. Gray Commissioners, A. S. Mitchell County Clerk W. A. Cooper Sheriff, when the following proceedings were had to-wit:

In the matter of establishing the Boundaries of Precinct No. 1.

April 1st 1911, On this day came on to be considered the matter of having the Boundaries of Precinct No. 1. Surveyed in order to get a correct description of said Precinct in order to have a general stock law election in said Justice Precinct. It is therefore ordered that J. H. Cargile County Surveyor be authorized to run out and survey the boundaries of ~~the~~ Justice Precinct NO. 1. that is the lines that are not already well established, and to make a plot of said Justice precinct such as the law requires to be made in order to well establish said precinct lines, and he is allowed the sum of \$5.00 per day together with the necessary help.

In the matter of Purchasing a car load of Steel for culverts.

April 3rd. 1911 on this day came on to be considered the matter of Purchasing a car load of corrugated Steel for culverts, and there being several culvert company represented, and all making sealed bids, and Austin bros. Making the best bid to the interest of the County the Court is of the opinion that the order should be given to Austin Bros. at the contract prices. It is therefore ordered by the court that they give the order to Austin Bros. of Dallas, Texas for a car load of Culverts at contract price.

In the Matter of refunding money to W. W. Smith constable

April 3 A. D. 1911 On this day came on to be considered the matter of refunding to W. W. Smith money received from him that he received for selling a cow under the general stock law, and it appearing to the court that said general stock law had been done away with and was of no further force and effect and that said sale was null and void. It is therefore ordered that said money be and the same is ordered to be refunded to said W. W. Smith to be payed over to the proper person to receive it.

In the matter of J. P. Boyd a Pauper, April 3 1911 on this day came on to be considered the matter of J. P. Boyd a Pauper, and it is ordered by the court that he be allowed the sum of \$12.00 per month.
