

As it remembered that on Monday May 9th A. D. 1911 there was begun and holden with inand for the county of Titus a regular term of the Honorable Commissioners court, with W. E. Riddle presiding, present R. B. White, H. W. West, J. O. Brown and R. J. Gray, commissioners, J. A. Cooper Sheriff and A. K. Mitchell County Clerk when the following proceedings were had-to-wit:

In the matter of surveying out the West Boundary Line of Justice Precinct No. One Titus County, Texas.

On this the 8th day of May A. D. 1911, I do hereby to be considered the report of J. H. Cargile, County surveyor of Titus County, Texas, of the survey of the West Boundary line of Justice Precinct No. One. Which report is as follows, to-wit:

The State of Texas, County of Titus

In the County Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas.

To the said Honorable Court:-

Now comes J. H. Cargile County surveyor in and for the said State and County and makes the following report of the Survey of the West Boundary Line of Justice Precinct No. One of Titus County, Texas, made by him in Persuance to an order of the said Court at a former term of the said Court.

The full field notes of the said survey is as follows, to-wit:

A survey of the West Line of Precinct No. 1 in Titus County, Texas.

Beginning at the center of the court house in Mt. Pleasant,, Titus County, Texas.--- Thence W at 2147 vrs. the W. B. line of the Berry Merchant and the E. B. Line of the A. Ripley surveys at 2 miles and 247 vrs, cross said ripley a W. B. and T. L. Ripley's E. B. line at 2 miles and 1591 vrs. cross T. L. Ripley's W. B. and J. H. Crooks E. In the Matter of Buying right of way for road from Josh Rhymes.

May 22 1911, On this day came on to be considered the matter of Purchasing right of way for Mt. Pleasant and Leesburg Public Road from Josh Rhymes after considering the matter the court is of the opinion that it is necessary to buy the said right of way in order to make the road nearer and better, and that the said Rhymes ask \$11.00 for said right of way which is reasonable It is therefore ordered adjudged and decreed by the court that the clerk issue warrant for \$11.00 to the said Rhymes.

In the matter of PAUPers

May 22nd A. D. 1911 on this day came on to be considered the application of Willie Heath a Blind negro for alms, and it appearing to the court that he is in need of help, the court is of the opinion that the county should help him some It is therefore ordered by the court that he be allowed the sum of \$4.00 per month for three Months Beginning May 22nd 1911.

Also came on to be considered the application of Joe Ferguson for a raise and it appearing to the court that he is in very feeble condition and lots of trouble to wait on. It is therefore ordered adjudged and decreed by the court that he be allowed \$3.00 per month.

In the matter of transcribing Deed Index records of Titus County

May 10th 1911, On this day came on to be considered the matter of having transcribed the Deed Index of Titus County, and it appearing to the court that said index is in bad condition and in need of transcribing, and that the present system is not a good one entirely out of date, it is therefore ordered by the court that the County Clerk A. S. Mitchell or scribe the said index into new records which the court has today purchased from Dorsey Printing Co. and the said A. S. Mitchell is to receive the sum of \$150.00 for said service.
