

Be it remembered that on July 10th A. D. 1911 there was begun and helden within and for the county of Titus a regular monthly term of the Hon. Commissioners Court, with W. E. Riddle County Judge Presiding, present commissioners R. B. White, H. W. West and R. J. Gray also J. A. Cooper sheriff and S. M. Hill County Clerk when the following proceedings were had to-wit:

In the Matter of the Petition of J. B. Tennison et als for a general stock law election to be held in Precinct No. One.

July 10th A. D. 1911. On this day came on to be considered by the Commissioners Court of Titus County Texas, a petition signed by J. B. Tennison, W. G. Black et als praying for an election to be held in Justice Precinct No. I. Described as follows:

Bounded on the East as follows: Beginning at a point four miles East from the center of the Courthouse in the town of Mt. Pleasant, Texas, a post on the Joshua S. Hill headright survey m.d. P. & 4 and a black jack brs. N. 56° W. 5-1/2 vrs. Mkd. P. L. --- Thence North to the Clarksville and Know Hill road a red Oak tree brs. South and East of line mkd. P. L. Still North to the St. Louis Southwestern R. R. crossing the said road about midway between what is known as the Dilleyton Coal Mine and the West fence of the Jack Moon farm a post oak brs. N. and E. of line mkd. PCL still North entering a small farm owned by Mrs. Jack Moor, a Post Oak brs. S. and W. of line mkd. PCL still North through said farm, a portion of the W. F. Willson farm to the Mt. Pleasant and Cookville Road a Post on line South of road marked PCL and M. P. and C. V. mill North A. S. C mbr's old place now owned by Walter Miller, passing through his field about 150 yards west from his house and entering Billie Harper's field about 100 yards Northwest from his house and passing through said field and entering Thomas Davis' field passing about 150 yards West of his house and at the edge of timber, a Black Jack brs. E. Mkd. B. L. and still North through timber to Liberty Hill and County Line Public Road, the same being the South Boundary line of Argo Justice Precinct No. 7.

Thence West with the Liberty Hill and County Line Public Road to the Hart's Bluff road at t e widow Crawford's place Thence North with the Hart's Bluff road to White Oak Creek at Even's Bridge on the said Creek.

The South Part of the Said Line begins at said post four miles East of the Court house located on Joshua S. Hill Headright survey, Thence South & striking J. C. Kirby's Farm, passing through the same about 150 yards East of his house and crossing the Mt. Pleasant and Jefferson road a post on line mkd. P. L. from which a Black Jack brs. S. 85° W. 9 yards, another brs. S.

46° E. 14 yards totl mkd. P. L. and still south to M. C. Rogers farm and through said farm to the Mt. Pleasant and Cason road, leaving his house about 10 feet East of line a large stone in line from which a red Oak brs. N. 2° W. 11 vrs. Mkd. PL and still south through said farm to J. W. Roger's farm and passing about 200 yards West of his house entering timber a red oak Mkd. P. L. running still south to Mr. Armstrong's farm about 200 yards West of his house and still south to Mrs. McElroy's farm passing through same about 1/2 of a mile west of her house and entering F. B. Dubose's farm West of his house and entering D (G) W. Rust farm 200 yards East of his house and still South crossing Cypress School House Road and Branch a birch Mkd. P. L. comes to Mrs. McNeal's farm running East of her house about 150 yards, comes to Mt. Pleasant and Cypress Road at J. H. Rogers House a post Oak Mkd. P. L. comes to P. G. Williams horse lot 27 yards West from his house, comes to Jack Cook's farm in the edge of Cypress Bottom comes to North Bank of Big Cypress, a stake a willow Oak brs. N. 35° W. 5 vrs. Mkd. PCL.

Said Justice Precinct No. One of Titus County, Texas is bounded on the South as follows: Beginning at the point where the said East Boundary line intersect with Big Cypress Creek, a post on the bank of same from which a willow Oak brs. N. 35° W. 5 vrs. Mkd. PCL. Thence up the said Creek in a westerly direction with the meanderings of the said creek to a point where the West Boundary line of the said Justice Precinct No. One intersects with the said creek, a post set in the North Bank of Big Cypress Creek, from which a Hickory brs. N. 3 vrs. mkd. PL.

The West Boundary line of the said Justice Precinct No. One is described as follows: Beginning at an Iron Pipe set in ground four miles West from the center of the Courthouse (in Mt. Pleasant, Texas) from which a post Oak brs. N. 23½° E. 79 vrs. mkd. P. C. --- Thence South at 438 vrs. cross Said (E) Leach S. B. and Joel Holbert's N. B. line 750 vrs. W. of Leach's S. E. Corner and 465 vrs. W. of Holbert's N. E. Corner pass East of Lon Barrett's about 250 yards at 1 mile set post on Holbert's Survey, at 1 mile and 428 vrs. cross Holbert's S. B. line and J.H. Keith's N.B. line 465 vrs. W. of Holbert's S. E. corner and 1425 vrs. E. of J. H. Keith's W. N. W. corner at 2 miles set post in Keith's Survey pass about 250 yards West of Tom Millions at 2 miles and 1760 vrs. Cross Mt. Pleasant, and Monticello Road at 3 miles and 134 vrs. cross Keith's S. B. line and R. M. Collin's N. B. line 776 vrs. W. of Keith's S. E. corner and 194 vrs. E. of Col Ins N. W. corner at 3 miles and 598 vrs. cross Collin's S. B. line and Joseph Meacham's P. line 1240 vrs. W. of Meacham's N. E. corner at 3 miles and 1365 vrs. the center of Short's Creek at 4 miles set post in Meacham's Survey at 5 miles set post in Meacham's Survey about 300 yards West of J. B. Stephens' House at 5 miles and 1240 vrs. Blandell's Creek at 6 miles and 40 vrs. set post on North Bank of Big Cypress from which a Hickory brs. N. 3 vrs. Mkd. P.L.

The North End of The Said Line is described as follows:

Beginning four miles West from the center of the Courthouse in Mt. Pleasant; THENCE NORTH 177 yrs. set post at the Mt. Pleasant and Wifield Road at 204 yrs. the center of Cotton Belt Railroad at 682 yrs Dragon Creek at 1077 yrs. cross E. Leach's N. B. Line and W. L. Downing S. B. line 715 yrs. N. of each is N. E. Corner and Downing's S. E. Corner Pass West of M. A. Wright's about 75 yards at 1000 yrs. set post in Downing's survey at 1 mile and 187 yrs. cross said Downing N. B. Line and Joseph Leach S. E. Line 445 yrs. E. of Downing's W. N. W. Corner and 150 yrs. went off Joseph Leach's S. E. Corner pass W. of Yurt Meadow about 100 yards & 2 Miles set post in J. Leach's Survey about 200 yards East of S. M. Meadow at 2 Miles on 400 yrs. cross the Mt. Pleasant and Pope Bridge road crossing said road 504 yrs. W. of Mrs. Marcs' house at 2 miles and 1852 yrs. cross Leach's N. B. Line and S. B. B. B. & C. Ry, CG&S 180 yrs. W. of Leach's N. E. and B. B. B. & C. Ry Co's S. E. E. Corner at 3 Miles set post in B. B. B. & C. Ry Co survey at 3 miles & 165 yrs. cross N. B. line of B. B. B. & C. Ry at 3 miles and 165 yrs. cross Landrum's S. B. line and James Hayes S. B. line 32 yrs. E. 3 miles and 1450 yrs. cross Landrum's N. B. Line and James Hayes S. B. line 32 yrs. E. of Landrum's N. W. Corner and 372 yrs. E. of James Hayes S. W. corner set post in Ha's survey pass W. of Dr. Leftwich about 450 yards at 4 Miles and 675 yrs. cross Hwy N. B. Line and T. T. Morris S. B. line 370 yrs. E. of Hayes N. W. Corner and Morris S. W. corner pass W. of Dard Roberson's about 200 yards at 4 Miles 1318 yrs. Cross Mt. Pleasant and Paris Road pass about 100 yards W. of J. H. Colley's and about 100 yards E. of Geo. Johnson's At 5 Miles set post in Forts survey at 5 Miles 675 yrs. cross Forts N. B. line and Rusben Hayes S. B. Line 370 yrs. E. of Forts N. W. Corner and Hayes S. W. Corner Pass W. of Bob Hayes about 125 yards at 6 Miles set Post in the R. Hayes survey at 6 Miles 505 yrs. cross Hayes N. B. line and W. N. Bridges S. B. line 375 yrs. E. of Hayes N. W. Corner and 127 yrs. E. of Bridges S. W. Corner Pass W. of J. W. Rosses about 75 yards at 6 miles and 690 yrs. cross Mt. Pleasant and Clarksville road pass E. of V. Measors about 250 yards and 6 miles and 1400 yrs. cross Bridges N. B. line and C. Williams S. B. line 80 yrs. E. of Bridges N. W. W. Corner and Williams S. W. Corner at 7 miles set post in C. Williams survey at 7 Miles 484 yrs. cross Williams N. B. line and the S. B. line of another B. B. B. & C. Survey 81 yrs. E. of William N. W. Corner and 362 yrs. E. of B. B. B. & C. S. W. Cor. pass E. of Willin Ellis About 5 yrs. and East of Will Corey about 325 yards at 8 miles set post in said B. B. B. & C. survey at 8 miles and 584 yrs. cross the N. B. Line of said B. B. B. & C. Ry Co. and the S. B. line of the S. W. Winsted survey 362 yrs. E. of the N. W. C. rner of the said Railroad survey and 720 yrs. W. of Hill's S. E. Cor. Winsted survey pass E. L. F. Jones about 250 yards & 8 Miles and 1084 yrs. Winsted's N. B. and Joe Salmerd's S. B. line cross said line 230 yrs. E. of Salmon's S. W. Cor. at 9 Miles and 22 yrs. set post at Mt. Pleasant and Clarksville road at 9 miles 430 yrs. cross Belbonds N. B. Line and Thos. Hill's S. B. line 252 yrs. W. of Hill's S. E. Cor. pass East of J. L. Hayes S. B. line 231 yrs. W. of Hill's S. E. Cor. cross East of W. Myers about 150 yards at 10 miles set post in Thos. Hill survey at 10 Miles 570 yrs. cross Hill's N. B. line and T. H. Blane's S. B. line 252 yrs. W. of Hill's N. E. Corner and Blane Black's S. E. Corer at 10 Miles 1140 yrs. A red Oak on S. Bank of White Oak Bayou from which a white oak brn 'S 50° W. 13 yrs. Hickory brs. E. 7. 5 yrs. both mdd & c.

All Posts are Marked P. L.

Thence East with the Meanderings of the said White Oak Bayou (White Oak Creek) to the Evans Bridge on the said White Oak Bayou or creek where the Mt. Pleasant and Harts Bluff road crosses the same.

Said election to be held in Said Justice Precinct No. I. to determine whether or not horses Mules Jacks Jetties and cattle shall be permitted to run at large or not Said petition appearing to be in proper form as required by law It is therefore ordered by the Court that Said election be held on the 19th day of August 1911 and that the polls be opened at voting precincts Nos 1, 2 & 3 at 8 o'clock A. M. and be closed at 7 o'clock P. M. ~~and~~

In the Matter of changing date of holding Justice Court at Argo Precinct No. 7. July 10 1911 on this day ye me on to be considered the matter of changing date of holding Justice Court in Precinct No. 7; and it appearing to the court that the regular date of said Court is on the Second Monday and that it will interfere with the dates of the Commissioners Court hereafter and that Square Gray the Justice of the Peace is a commissioner and that for his convenience the date of holding said court should be changed to the first Monday in each month It is therefore ordered that the date of holding Justice Court in Precinct No. 8 be changed from the Second Monday to the First Monday in each month.

In the Matter of Giving J. W. Myers permission to get lumber.  
It is ordered by the court that J. W. Myers be allowed to go to Cookville and get 200 feet of lumber to built culvert near his house.
