Therefore by the law vested in me as County Judge of Titus County, Texas, I hereby decree and by these presents declare that it will be unlawful in Justice Precinct No. One of Titus County, Texas to let horses, mules, Jacks, Jennetts and cattle run at large unrestricted from and after the 29th day of Sept. A. D. 1911
