Riddle County Judge Presiding, Commissioners present: A.B. White, H.W. West, A.D. Bohannon and R.J. Gray, A.S. Mithers County Clerk and J.W. Cooper Sheriff, when the following proceedings were had to-wit:—

On the Matter of Approving ^{Sept} Rolls of Titus ³ Sept 9th 1911
 As compiled by H.B. Seaton Tax assessor ³ On this day came on to be considered the matter of examining and approving the Tax Rolls for Titus County, and it appearing to the Court from inspection that the Rolls were correct and were in neat form it is therefore ordered adjudged and decreed by the Court that said Tax Rolls for the year 1911 be and the same are approved by the Court

On the Matter of purchasing an ³ Sept 9-1911
 Adding Machine for Titus Co. ³ On this day came on to be considered the matter of purchasing an adding machine from Burroughs Co. and it appearing to the Court that said Machine is very much needed. It is therefore ordered and adjudged by the Court that Judge Riddle be authorized to buy said Machine and pay \$200.00 for same

On the Matter of John Lucas ³ Sept 9th 1911
 A Pauper. ³ On this day came on to be considered by the Court the Matter of allowing John Lucas the Sum of \$4.50 for 3 months for three months, and it appearing to the Court that he has no support and that he is in needy circumstances, it is therefore ordered adjudged and decreed by the Court that he be allowed the sum of \$4.50 per month for 3 months

On the Matter of resignation of ³ Sept 9th - 1911
 A.B. White Commissioner ³ On this day came on to be considered the matter of the resignation of A.B. White Commissioner Precinct No 1, and it appearing to the Court that A.B. White is going to move to California and desire the Court to accept his resignation it is therefore ordered adjudged

In the matter of building ³ Sept 9th 1911

Winfield Jail

All this day came on to be considered the matter of building a jail at Winfield Texas, and appearing to the court that the citizens of Winfield would bear half the expense of building said jail and that the same is very much needed.

It is therefore ordered adjudged and decreed by the court that the sum of \$150⁰⁰ be paid to committee appointed to help build said jail.

Commissioner for precinct No 1 ³ All this day came on to be considered the matter of appointing a Commissioner for precinct No 1. to fill the unexpired term of R.P. White who resigned Sept 9th 1911, and the matter having been submitted to a vote of the people in said precinct on Sept 22-1911 and there being 4 candidates for said place, and A.P. Smart receiving the greatest No of votes for said Commissioner, at S.W.C. Riddle County Judge of Tarrant County Texas do hereby appoint A.P. Smart Commissioner of Precinct no 1 to fill the unexpired term of said R.P. White.
