Be it remembered that on Oct 9th 1911. there was begun and holden within and for the County of Tulsa. A regular monthly term of the Hon. Commissioners Court with W.E. Riddle County Judge presiding and Commissioners A.P. Smith, H.W. West, R.J. King and A.O. Brown, A.S. Mitchell County clerk and J. C. Cooper Sheriff present when the following proceedings were had to-wit:—
