 on the 25th day of Nov. AD. 1911. to determine whether or
 not horses, mules, Jacks, Jennettes & Cattle be permitted
 to run at large on the range or not in said Justice
 Precinct No 8. in Tarrant County. On appearing from the votes
 cast at said election that there were 69 votes for said
 General Stock Law, and 29 votes against said General
 Stock Law, and that there were a majority of 40 votes
 in favor of said General Stock Law, therefore by the
 authority of law vested in me as Judge of Tarrant
 County, Texas, I hereby decree & by these presents
 declare that it will be unlawful for horses, mules
 Jacks Jennettes & Cattle to run at large on the range
 in Justice Precinct No 8. in Tarrant County, Texas
 from and after Jan 4th AD. 1912. ~~From and after~~
