On the matter of Rebate on 3 }
 Taxes of First State Bank } Jan 8th 1912.
 Mt Pleasant for 1911 } All this day came on }
 to be considered the matter }
 of giving rebate on Taxes of First State Bank Mt. }
 Pleasant for 1911 and it appearing to the Court }
 that the rendition of said Bank for 1911 was higher }
