Oct 14-1912.

On this day came on to be considered the petition of Tom Temples et al for a public road of the 2nd class to-wit: - Beginning at a point on the Evans Bridge and Tharto Bluff public road near Old Harris at the corner of his pasture - thence across Said Harris land in a west course to the Widow Belvoir's East line - thence west across her land North of house - thence west across Lillister's land - thence west on said land line of Virgil Belvoir's - thence N. to the Page land - thence W. with the A.W. Pittman and Page land line to Pitt - Man N.W. corner - thence to the Lunny land line - thence west with the Lunny S. land line to the Tys' land - thence west across said land to T.R. McHens land thence west with said line to J.Tygi's East line the corner of said Tygi's land - thence west with J.Tygi's Belvoir line to Will Tygi - thence with Will Tygi's line in front of his house and with the road from W.Tygi to the John Tygi place - thence with the public to Thoro and its offering to the Court that said petition is signed by the required number of landholders and that said road petition should be granted and said road declared a second class Road when put in good order and same to be put in good condition to no expense to the County. It is therefore ordered that said be granted as prayed for and that said road be opened up with no expense to the County

School Bond of 3 On this day came on to be District No. 11 3 Considered the matter of paying \$2000⁰⁰ in School Bonds issued upon the faith and credit of Common School Dist No 11 of this County, Texas, and it appearing to the Court that Said bonds were issued for the purpose of building and equipping a School house and it appearing further that the permanent school fund has funds on hand that should be invested and that this is a good investment for same. It is therefore ordered adjudged and decreed by the Court that Said bond be purchased and taken up by the permanent school fund.

In the matter of 3 Oct. 14 - 1912.

Selling School house On this day came on to the Board Dist No 4. 3 be considered a petition of the Trustees of Common School

District No 4 asking for an order permitting them to sell at public auction the old School House and grounds in said dist. and it appearing to the Court that said dist has built a new School building and an order has just been given by them and that they have no further use for the old building & grounds.

It is therefore ordered adjudged that Said Trustees sell the old building and grounds on which it is located to the highest bidder.
